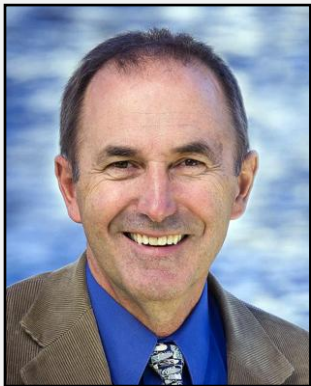


## Energy Realities
