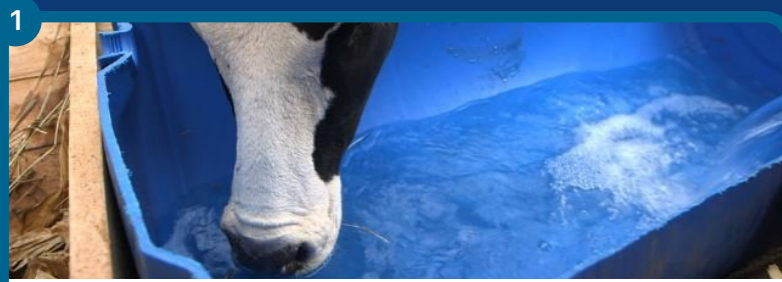


# Calf Rearing & Animal Husbandry



1 Always provide fresh and clean water to calves



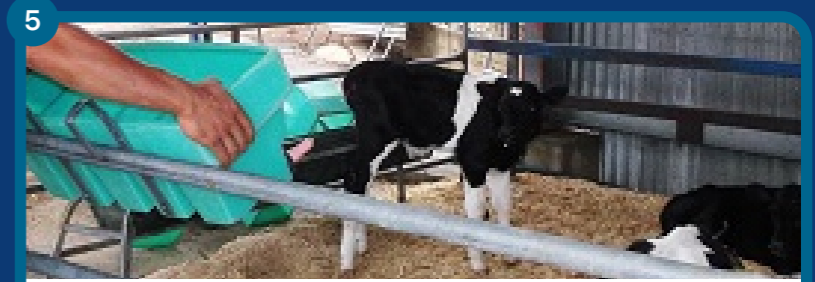
2 Feed 4lt of colostrum 6-12 hours after birth



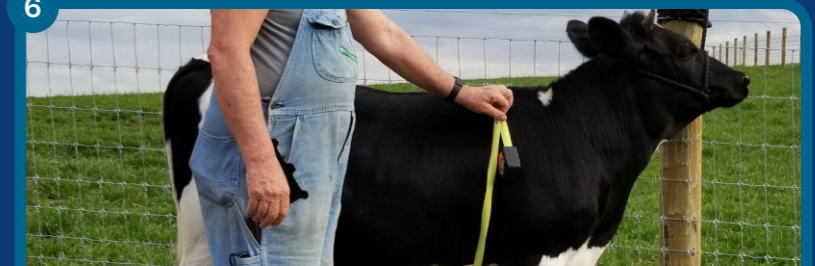
3 Feed small quantities of concentrate to calves 1 week after birth. Weaning when eating 1kg concentrate or body weight 90kg.



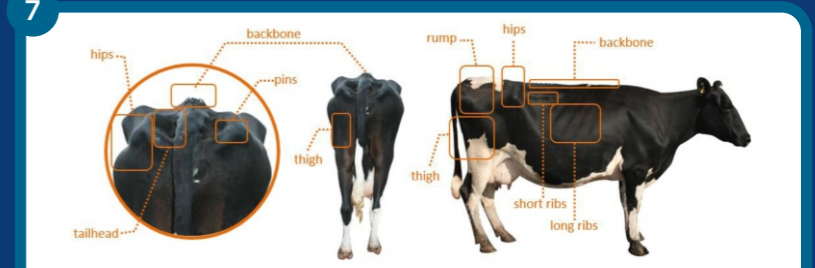
4 House calves in a clean crate, with water and concentrate and introduce small amounts of forage.



5 Don't house calves in drafts or direct sunlight. A little air movement is good.



6 Body weight heifer at first Artificial Insemination around 315-330kg



7 Body condition score of cows should be between 2.75-3.25 at calving and drying off



8 Ensure calves receive their vaccinations
