Report from the Chancellor

The Chancellor reported on recent events she attended including:

- the Law Alumni Dinner which was seeking to raise funds to endow a Chair in Evidence and Procedure to honour the achievements of Emeritus Fellow Andrew Ligertwood and the Hon. John Doyle AC KC;
- Graduation Ceremonies in May, including the awarding of Honorary Doctorates on Ms Carolyn Hewson AO, Prof John O'Neil AO, and Ms Danielle Wood;
- the Hugh Stretton Oration and dinner with Mr Adam Liaw as the keynote speaker; and
- the opening of the University's Wise and Wonderful Women exhibition.

She also addressed oversight of the disestablishment of the University.
