The John Monash Scholars

Mission of the General Sir John Monash Foundation

To invest in outstanding Australians from all fields of endeavour who demonstrate remarkable qualities of leadership and have the ability to deliver outcomes and inspire others for the benefit of Australia.

What makes it different to other Scholarships?

- Uniquely Australian, established in Australia for Australian citizens, for the benefit of Australia.
- Open for people of all ages and from all fields of endeavour to undertake a postgraduate degree (Masters or PhD) overseas.
- Not restricted by where you would like to complete your postgraduate degree overseas, as long as you can demonstrate why it is the best place in the world for your proposed study.

- The University of Groningen
- Weizmann Institute of Science

Special university focused scholarship

- The Roth/Segal John Monash Harvard Scholarship is awarded to a Scholar who has chosen to study at Harvard University.

What is it worth?

- Receive \$75,000 AUD for each year of study (maximum length of study is 3 years at a total of \$225,000 AUD).
- Support to get to the location of your postgraduate study overseas from Australia.
- Receive an additional fee waiver from our partner universities including: Kings College London, Cranfield University, IE University, The University of Groningen and Weizmann Institute of Science.

Special university focused scholarships

- The Roth/Segal John Monash Harvard Scholarship is awarded to a Scholar who has chosen to study at Harvard University.

Eligibility criteria

- Be an Australian citizen.
- Have completed (or nearly completed) a degree with an Australian university.
- Be planning to undertake postgraduate study overseas commencing in the calendar year following the year of application.
- Be able to argue the merits of your chosen course, institution and how they are best positioned to drive progress in the chosen field of study.
- Applicants who have been successful in securing a Rhodes, Fulbright or Ramsay scholarship are ineligible for a John Monash Scholarship.

The application process

Online applications submitted each year (approximately)

Online applications open May 1st and close 17:00 July 1st AEST

Candidates shortlisted for first round interviews

First round interviews are held around Australia and via video conference for candidates overseas from August to September- see website for specific dates

40

Candidates shortlisted for national interviews

National interviews are held in Melbourne and Sydney over two days in each location in November - see website for specific dates

15-20 scholarships awarded annually

Scholarship offers are made in November

Key selection criteria

- Demonstrated excellence in your field
- Demonstrated or potential leadership ability
- A vision to deliver a positive impact for the benefit of Australia

The John Monash Scholars

To date, we have awarded 264 Scholarships to Australians to study in the fields of health and medicine, engineering, science, fine arts, education, law, political theory, business, entrepreneurship and much more.

John Monash Scholars are working in their chosen fields of expertise whilst actively responding to some of the greatest challenges of our time and shaping a positive future for Australia.

They receive the ongoing endorsement and support of the General Sir John Monash Foundation, John Monash Foundation Leadership Academy, as well as our governments, national corporate, academic and private supporters, and related international networks.

When do applications open?

Applications open every year on the 1st of May and close at 17:00 on the 1st of July. After the close date, applications are shortlisted for two rounds of interviews that take place between August and October - for exact interview dates keep an eye on the website. After the interview process has been completed 15-20 Scholarships will be awarded.

How do I apply?

Once applications open, go to www.johnmonash.com/applications follow the link to the online portal to create your application profile. You can edit, save and continue working on your application up until the close date.
