Making an Application, you must currently be onshore in Australia or the United Kingdom

Applicants are required to lodge a **separate** online **Admission** application for each project they wish to be considered for.

In the study preference section you must select Joint Award and indicate University of Nottingham in the partner University

The project ID and title must be included in the Research Interests field within the online application form. There is a limit of one project per application.

Example: GHW-01 The role of local microbiota in the aetiopathogenesis of oral squamous cell carcinoma

Applicants must complete the online application form and upload all requested documentation. Where you are applying for more than one project, you must create a separate application and upload your documents into each application.

- Supervision confirmation – please upload a pdf version of the email received from the supervisor confirming supervision to apply for the Joint Nottingham PhD Program
