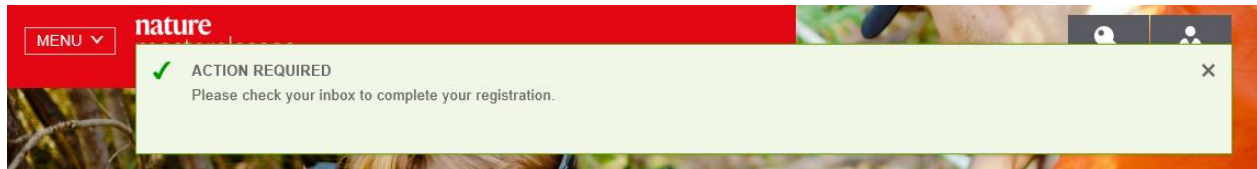

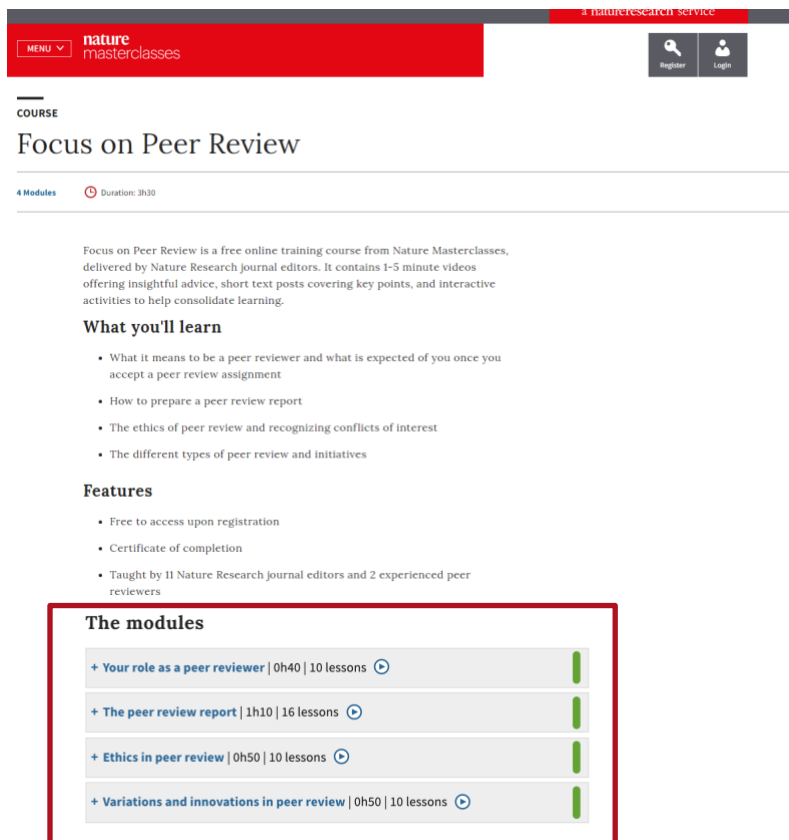


4. Click the blue Start the Course button.
