Activity Title: enter the corresponding course's title

Provider: LinkedIn Learning

Dates and Times: enter the date of completion and a duration equivalent to the corresponding credits (e.g. for 1 credit enter 08:00 – 9:00)

Activity type: Training

RDF Domain : enter the corresponding domain

Upload your certificate as evidence, then enter a short description and reflection, and submit.
