First aid QR posters

Safety Notice

A power outlet burnt out from use of a domestic oil heater in a damp environment. The power outlet showed clear signs of damage and should not have been used. The oil heater was disposed of, and the damaged power outlet was replaced following a service request.

The key message should be if damaged infrastructure is identified, isolate or tag it out and report it via a service request - Infrastructure | University of Adelaide.

Where there is damaged or suspect equipment that is managed by a School or Branch isolate or tag it out and report it via <u>UniSafe</u>.
