This guidance is an extract of the relevant responsibilities for all persons from the University HSW procedure for Noise & Sound Safety Management. The responsibilities listed below apply to all persons engages in a task or activity or working in an area that contains hazardous noise. Where persons require advice on how to meet these requirements in their workplaces, they should contact hswteam@adelaide.edu.au.

Process: Hazard Management
Report any work-related noise and sound safety issue(s) you identify, which has the potential to expose
you or others to hazardous noise (see Appendix A as a guide) in accordance with the Report a safety issue
or incident HSW Handbook chapter to ensure appropriate investigation and follow-up
Process: Controlling the risks of hazardous noise
Review and comply with the control measures in noise risk assessments prior to undertaking work in noisy
workplaces or with noise and sound emitting plant, equipment, or items.
☐ Report plant/equipment or tasks which increase noise and sound levels to your Supervisor/person in
control of the area/activity.
☐ Record all noise and sound related safety issues or incidents in the on-line system.
☐ Identify sources of noise and sound that may cause or contribute to hearing loss, and if necessary, assess
the risks associated with these hazards in consultation with your Supervisor/person in control of the
area/activity.
