Internship guidelines

We ask hosts to provide interns with:

- A project or tasks of relevance to your business or industry.
- Suitable work space and facilities.
- On site supervision.
- Health and safety induction on commencement.
- Feedback on the student's performance.

How it works

Our team are here to assist you throughout the internship process, from scoping the best project and shortlisting students, to coordinating paperwork and providing feedback. An overview of the internship process is as follows:

Scope

Our team will assist you to scope a project or tasks based on business need and obtain University approval.

Recruitment

Our team will promote your internship opportunity to suitable students and manage applications.

Shortlisting

Out team will shortlist applications and send through a recommended shortlist for you to decide on the successful student. You choose how involved you want to be with this process.

Agreement

Our team will coordinate the relevant paperwork and agreements to cover off on responsibilities, agreed tasks, timing, confidentially, IP and insurance. As students undertake internships as part of their university studies, they are generally a vocational placement under the Fair Work Act.
