

Accessing the Detailed Course Report

The Detailed Course Report is now available for all courses in MyUni, providing teaching staff with an overview of student demographics and previous results.

1. Go to LMS Analytics

From your course homepage, click on the LMS Analytics menu item.

If the LMS Analytics menu item is not available, you may need to activate it by going to the Settings menu item, clicking on the navigation tab and selecting the LMS Analytics item from the disabled items section. Select 'Enable' on the dropdown that appears and then click save at the bottom of the page

3. Enter your username and password

You may be asked to enter your username (A number) and password. Enter these details and click okay. The report will begin to run. Depending on the size of the course, this may take a few minutes.



4. Viewing the report

Depending on your browser settings, the report will generate in different ways. It may appear on screen, allowing you to download it (via right click or as shown below). You may instead be prompted to save/open the report, or the report may open automatically in another tab/window.

Troubleshooting

Receiving an error message when accessing the report? Try the following:

1. Ensure you are connected to the VPN if working remotely

Generating the Detailed Course Report requires access to the University Network. If you are working remotely, you will need to log in remotely via the University VPN. Details for logging in via VPN can be found <u>here.</u>

2. Try using a different internet browser or clearing your cache

The issue may be browser specific – try an alternative browser (Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Edge). Alternatively, you may need to clear your cache. Instructions for doing so for all browsers can be found via this website.

3. Use Incognito or private modes with your browser

If a different browser or clearing the cache does not resolve the problem try accessing the report using Incognito or Private mode on your browser. Instructions for the most commonly used browsers can be found below.

4. Stay on the Detailed Course Report tab when report is generating
