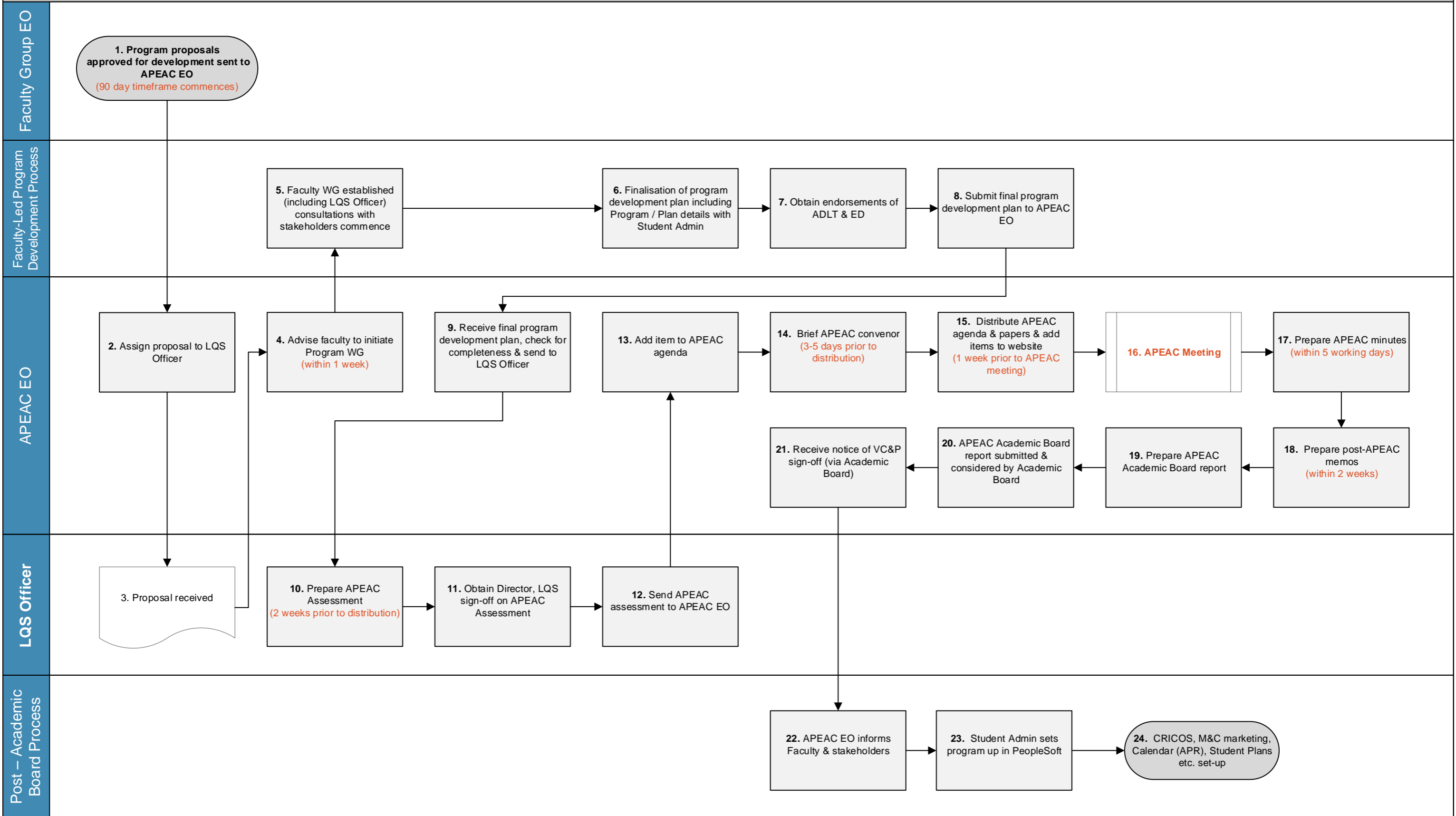


APEAC Process for Program Development



Key Points

- 1-15: Proposals must progress from stages 1-15 within 90 days to be considered at the next scheduled APEAC meeting.
- 5: The first meeting of the WG must occur no later than 1 week following the approval of the concept and will include a representative from Marketing & Communications as well as the LQS Officer. Subsequent WG meetings require a range of consultations with relevant stakeholders (see form & website).
- 7: The ADLT& ED must endorse the final program development plan before it is submitted.
- 10-11: The APEAC agenda item template comprises a declaration by the Director, LQS that the program is quality assured and compliant (or not) with internal and external frameworks. Advice from M&C is included in the assessment.
- 19-20: Academic Board report includes a summary of the APEAC discussion and recommendations, and includes a URL where the program plan proposal, APEAC assessment and APRs can be accessed.
