Review Rejoinder

A rejoinder allows you as a peer reviewee to address any issues raised by the reviewers which you think need to be clarified, contextualised or corrected. It is not a criticism of the reviewers, but an adding of information from your perspective about the session of your teaching that you presented to the reviewers, which might be helpful to the panel looking at your peer review reports.
