

Course Readings: requesting digitization of a journal article

Introduction

If you need to include a journal article in your reading list and there is no digital version available, you can request that the Library digitize it for you via your reading list.

Procedure

- 1. Find the journal containing the article you wish to include and add it to your reading list.
- 2. In the list, click on the title of the article to see the details page.



3. Click on the **Digitization request** link.



4. In **Chapters:** enter the article title, volume, issue and page range.

Ask Library for Digital Copies
NOTE: Add a single chapter number or page range for scanning. If you need an additional chapter from the same source add a separate citation and place a Digitization Request. For journal articles add volume, issue and page range in Chapters field.
