

# Course Readings: add items using Cite It!

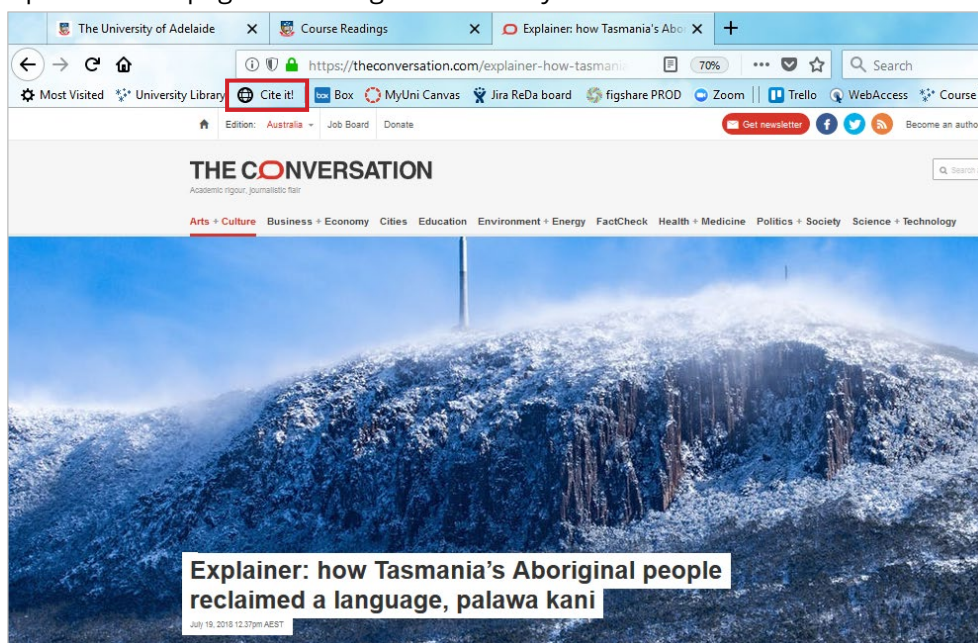
## Introduction

Once you have installed the Cite It! bookmarklet on your Bookmarks Toolbar you can easily add web content, such as blogs, articles or videos, to your reading list.

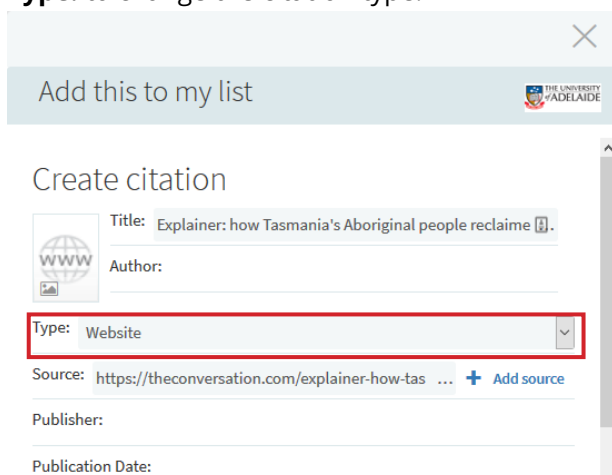
You need to have MyUni open before you can add content.

## Procedure

1. Open the web page containing the content you want to add and click the **Cite It!** bookmarklet icon.



2. A pop-up window will appear with pre-populated information. Click on the drop-down arrow next to **Type:** to change the citation type.



**Note:** if you can't see a window, make sure you have pop-ups enabled for your browser.

3. Add any additional information required (e.g. author, publisher or date) to the empty fields. The options will vary depending on which citation type you selected.
