## 2. Ask Library

# 3. Borrowing

- · Borrow up to 20 items at a time.
- Standard loan time is 4 weeks.
- Items may be requested by another student at any time and if that occurs you will have 7 days to return the item.

# 4. Register with MyLibrary

When you first become a member of the library you will have to create an account on the MyLibrary sign-in page using your registered email address.

Registration is quick and easy:

- Create an individual account using the barcode from your library card as the username and your own personal email address.
- Once you have registered you will be able to login to MyLibrary. In the username field, enter either your library card barcode or registered email address. As part of the registration process you will have been prompted to create your own password.

Login to MyLibrary at any time to see what you have on loan and your item's due dates.

- Access to online resources is limited due to licensing restrictions. You can use the library's public access computers to search and access most online resources.

## 6. Scanning

You can scan to a USB drive at no charge on all multi-function devices within the library.

There is a flat-bed scanner on Level 3 of the Barr Smith Library which allows scanning to USB, email, phone or tablet, and various cloud drives.

Printing and photocopying are not available.
