

Course Readings: moving items in a reading list

Introduction

You can move items in your reading list both within and between sections by using the drag-and-drop function or by clicking the citation's up and down arrows.

Procedure

1. Hover the mouse anywhere within the item that you wish to move until the blue **Drag citation** area appears.
2. Click-and-drag in the blue area to move the item up or down.

3. Once the item is in the desired location, release the mouse button.

Alternatively click the up or down arrows at the top and bottom of the blue area to move the citation one place at a time
