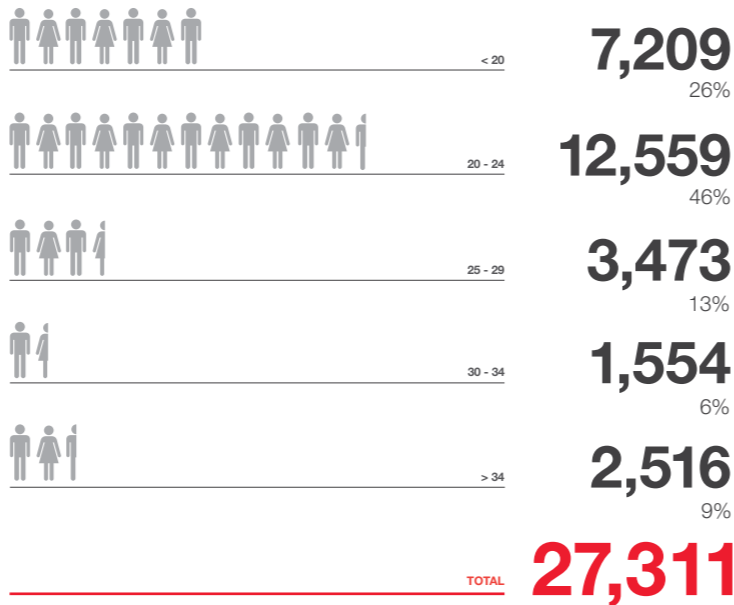

Program enrolments by age group



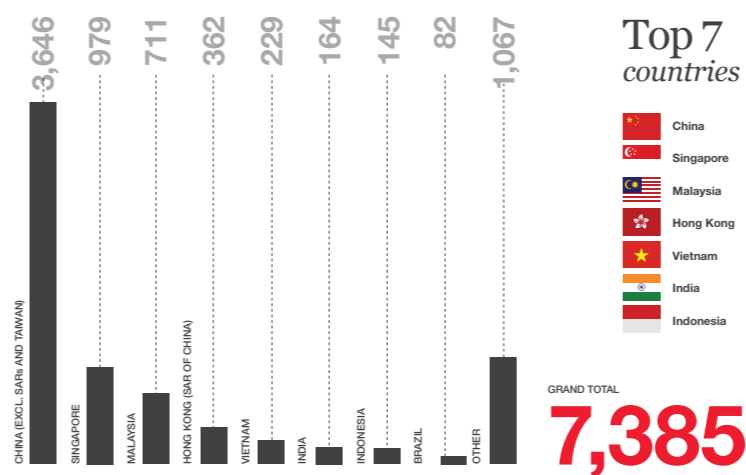

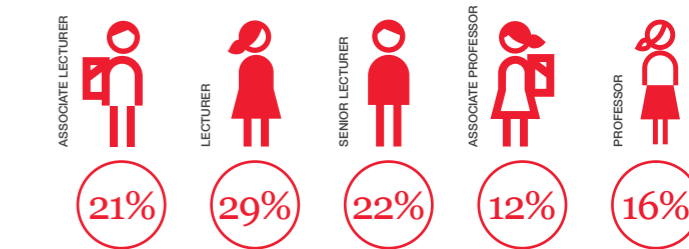

ACADEMIC STAFF BY LEVEL (PERSONS)

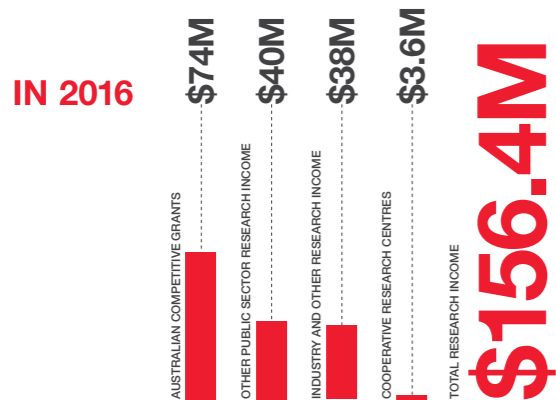

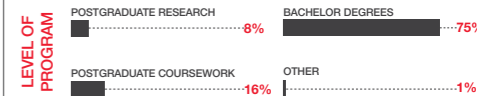
