

Rules for Graduation Ceremonies

- 1. Subject to Chapter 89 of the Statutes, candidates who have satisfied the requirements for any award of the University shall be admitted to that award.
- 2. Graduation ceremonies will be presided over by the Chancellor, Deputy Chancellor, or other Council member appointed by the Chancellor for the purpose.
- 3. Every candidate for admission to an award in the University shall be presented by the Vice-Chancellor and President or the Executive Dean of the relevant Faculty or nominee, but may be admitted either in person or in absentia.
- 4. The forms of presentation to awards shall be determined by the Vice-Chancellor and President.
