



Funding from the Tobacco Industry Policy

OVERVIEW

The Policy sets out a clear and explicit public statement on the University's position regarding funding from the Tobacco Industry.

SCOPE AND APPLICATION

This Policy applies to all staff, students and titleholders of the University of Adelaide who are involved in the conduct of research associated with the University.

POLICY PRINCIPLES

1. The University of Adelaide will not accept research funding offered to the institution or to individual researchers by the tobacco industry, excluding tobacco taxes applied by governments to support health and welfare related projects; nor will it advertise such grant opportunities.
