<i>By what authority:</i>	Deputy Vice-Chancellor and Vice-President (Research)
<i>For what period:</i>	Indefinite

Role/Terms of Reference

<i>Nature:</i>	The Committee is established to provide advice on issues relating to research integrity within the University.
<i>Terms of Reference:</i>	Advises the Deputy Vice-Chancellor and Vice-President (Research) on issues relating to research integrity, and implementation of the Australian Code for the Responsible Conduct of Research, within the University. Members may be invited to sit on research misconduct evaluation panels, if not involved in the actual case.
<i>Reporting line:</i>	To the Deputy Vice-Chancellor and Vice-President (Research)
<i>Quorum:</i>	No quorum
<i>Procedures prescribed/determined itself:</i>	None
<i>Frequency of meetings:</i>	Once or twice per year
<i>List of any sub-committees:</i>	None

<i>Any categories prescribed:</i>	1. Deputy Vice-Chancellor and Vice-President (Research) or nominee (<i>ex officio</i>) [Convenor] 2. Pro Vice-Chancellor (Research Operations) (<i>ex officio</i>) 3. All Research Integrity Advisers, as approved by the Pro Vice-Chancellor (Research Operations) The Vice-Chancellor and President is an <i>ex officio</i> member of all Committees of the University.
<i>Term of Office:</i>	Except for <i>ex officio</i> members, individual membership will be reviewed annually.
