- ¹ Students who have successfully completed Year 12 Mathematical Methods should directly enrol in the Advanced Maths course. Students may complete both the Basic and Advanced courses, the Advanced course counting as an elective when completed after the Basic.

Open Electives and Broadening Electives

Open (free choice) elective courses can be chosen from the Faculty of the Professions or any faculty in the University, where courses are not restricted.

Broadening elective courses are those which are outside their primary discipline area of study and can be searched using the [Course Planner](#)

To satisfy the requirements for Broadening Electives, students must complete courses to the value of 9 units. Students in the Bachelor of Economics must choose courses outside of the subject areas

specified in the [Broadening Electives list](#). These include ACCTING, CORPFIN, ECON, LAW, STATS.

It is recommended that you enrol for the full year. Semester – to enrol in 12 units per semester
