







我们也是编写有关太空冲突的全球权威性法律文本——"伍默拉手册"的主导者之一。我们的机器人视觉团队经常在国际挑战赛的排行榜中占有一席之地。

此外,阿德莱德大学的光子学和 先进感应研究者们还制造了世界 上最精确的时钟——蓝宝石时 钟,这是一种精确到飞秒的低温 蓝宝石振荡器。

同样引人注目的是,我们的健康研究人员领导了世界上最大的群体免疫研究——南澳大利亚2017-18年度B Part of It脑膜炎B疫苗试验,并且目前还在领导澳大利亚参与国际COVID嗅探犬项目。


