

ROCA AWARD OF MERIT 1984 – David Suter

Following graduation, **David Suter (RDA, 1942)** immediately entered the RAAF in which he served with distinction. After active duty, he returned to Roseworthy as Assistant Farm Superintendent and later as Farm Manager until 1958.

David left Roseworthy for the Lands Department as Supervisor of Land Development in the South-East then on Kangaroo Island. When "development" was completed there he transferred to Head Office and worked on a survey of the deep sand region out of Pinnaroo.

David rose to the position of Assistant Superintendent for Service Settlement by 1965, becoming Superintendent of Dry Lands in 1977, and retired as Assistant Regional Manager.

During his years at Roseworthy, David was Secretary of ROCA and intensely involved with the building of the Chapel. He subsequently became President of ROCA.
