Outcome

- Facilitated/negotiated resolution where appropriate.
- Disciplinary action where appropriate.
- Provide closure information to people involved in the matter.

Information

- Integrity Unit staff will discuss options for addressing the issues you have raised.
- Actions, timeframes and areas involved will depend on the matter and who is involved.
- Your information will be kept confidential. If this changes, we will let you know.
- Temporary precautionary measures (to keep you safe) may be implemented.

Action

- Assessment by Integrity Unit.
- Investigation (internal or external) may be undertaken.
- May be referred to relevant area for action (Integrity Unit retains oversight).
- You will be kept updated.

Do you want the University to take action?

- A disclosure will be recorded.
- You can raise a complaint later.
