

ADELAIDE SUMMER RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP 2022-2023

Up to 60 Summer Research Scholarships are available at the University of Adelaide in 2022-2023. The scholarships have been created to provide undergraduate students with experience working with a research team to encourage them to consider postgraduate study leading to a career involving research.

The Adelaide Summer Research Scholarships are available to undergraduate students, particularly those in the later years of their Bachelor's degree who wish to undertake a six-week project at the University of Adelaide over the 2022-2023 summer vacation.

Students should have completed at least two years (48 units) of study of their program, at a standard acceptable for admission to an Honours program. In exceptional circumstances, these scholarships may be awarded to students on completion of first year of the program, but only after consideration of the students who have completed second year.

Australian citizens, permanent residents of Australia, New Zealand Citizens, holders of a Permanent Humanitarian Visa and international students who hold current appropriate visas permitting study in Australia beyond February 2023 are eligible to apply for these scholarships.

Scholarships are available in all disciplines provided an appropriate research project is available within the Faculty/School. It is the responsibility of students to contact a supervisor to ensure that an appropriate research project is available.

Students who are in receipt of, or expect to receive any other summer or vacation scholarships over the 2022-2023 summer vacation (e.g. National Heart Foundation Summer Scholarship, Cancer Council Vacation Scholarships) are not eligible for the Adelaide Summer Research Scholarship unless the other scholarship is for a separate project.

Tenure

The scholarship duration is six weeks during the 2022-2023 summer semester.

Selection Criteria

The aim of the scholarship is to foster an interest in research by eligible students who might not otherwise have considered a career requiring an honours degree or higher degree.

The scholarships are awarded on the recommendation of the relevant Faculty/School/Discipline, to students of high academic merit, and the availability of a relevant research project within the Faculty/School, which would be beneficial and of interest to each student selected. As students will need to be matched to suitable research projects, the scholarships may not be awarded strictly based on academic merit.

The scholarships are intended to provide experience in a research project conducted by one or more academic staff and are not intended to support work towards an Honours degree, or for any other course requirements.

Benefits

Each scholarship provides a living allowance of \$1,200 as a one-off payment (paid in mid-January). Tax payments are not deducted from this payment. Recipients of the scholarship are responsible for seeking advice from the Australian Taxation Office regarding the status of the scholarship with regard to taxation.

Application Procedure

Students can only submit ONE application for ONE project. All attached forms must be completed and signed as required.
