



ACADEMIC PROGRESS BY COURSEWORK STUDENTS POLICY

All students are advised that the [Academic Progress for Coursework Students Policy](#) has been updated. The revised policy becomes effective on **1 January 2021** and it is important that you familiarise yourself with the updated policy.

Here are some of the important changes that you may need to know:

- The previous policy will continue to apply to study undertaken during Review Period 2, 2020. The new policy will be applied to study undertaken during Review Period 1, 2021 and to every Review Period after that.
- This policy will now apply to you if you are enrolled in a program at the Melbourne Campus or in a fully online program during an online teaching term.
- Courses failed whilst enrolled in the Degree Transfer Program or Pre-Masters Program at the University of Adelaide College will now be included in the risk status calculation when studying at the University
- If you are identified as being at Risk 1, you must now complete the self-reflective survey that will be sent to you and discuss the results with a staff adviser (contact your faculty for assistance with this).
- If you have a disability that would prevent you communicating at a show cause meeting, you may arrange for a support person to speak at the meeting on your behalf. Contact [Student Care](#) if you require assistance with this.
- Exclusion notices will now only be sent to your University email account (remember you can set this up to be forwarded to your personal email account). They will no longer be sent by registered mail.
