

2025 Information Sheet for Students

The Q Fever vaccination is a requirement for the majority of programs within the School of Animal and Veterinary Sciences (SAVS). Please refer to SAVS [Vaccination Guidelines](#) for more information.

Cost

All costs associated with testing and vaccination must be paid for by the student. The cost of testing and vaccinations vary from provider to provider (ranging from approximately \$220 to \$500). The consultation fee at a GP may be covered by Medicare and the vaccination may be covered by some private health insurance companies. Students are advised to consult their private health insurance provider regarding associated costs with the vaccine.

Q Fever Providers

While there are a number of Q-Fever providers across Australia, the School has connections with three clinics that are willing to take a group of students and as a result the cost is reduced (see below). Students can either source their own provider or book in with these clinics. Please note students CANNOT miss practicals and Tutorials run on the Roseworthy Campus to attend vaccination appointments.
