Exchange programs are semester or year-long experiences, choosing from over 100 partner universities around the world, on a fee-waiver basis.	Summer or Winter exchange is ideal if you want a shorter experience at one of our partner universities.	Study Tours are short programs (2-4 weeks) co-ordinated by academic staff with pre-set academic requirements and credit arrangements.	Self-reporting programs allow you to arrange your own experience, including placements, internships, summer/winter school, research or by joining a third party provider program.
