

Sign up or connect an ORCiD via Aurora

Introduction

ORCiD stands for **O**pen **R**esearcher and **C**ontributor **ID**. It is a persistent digital identifier that distinguishes you from every other researcher throughout your career. The University requires current and new Academic staff and Higher Degree by Research students to obtain an ORCiD.

Follow this guide to sign up for a new ORCiD and/or connect your existing ORCiD account via Aurora.

Sign up or connect an ORCiD via Aurora

<u>Aurora</u> (University of Adelaide Researcher Outputs, Reporting and Analytics) is the University's webbased system for capturing and reporting research publications, outputs, professional activities, and profile information.

Linking your ORCiD with your Aurora profile helps make your body of work accessible to others including potential collaborators, funders, prospective employers, conference organisers, publishers, and across universities as you move through your career.

To sign up or connect your existing ORCiD to Aurora:

- 1. Go to <u>https://www.adelaide.edu.au/aurora/</u> and sign in. **Note:** if accessing Aurora off-campus, you will be required to use a <u>Virtual Private Network (VPN)</u>.
- 2. Select 'Add your ORCiD' under 'My Actions' from your Homepage.



3. Alternatively, go to the Menu > Settings > Automatic claiming > Add external profiles > ORCiD

4. You will be prompted to log in to your ORCiD account with your email and password. If you do not have an ORCiD, select 'Register now' and complete the registration steps.

5. After signing in or signing up, you will be prompted to authorise the University access to your ORCiD record. Select 'Authorise access'.
