Introduction


Two new enhancements are now available in your University of Adelaide Researcher Profile:

- Showcase your **Teaching Strengths**
- Indicate your Availability for Media Comment

These additions will also be reflected in your Adelaide University Researcher Profile in 2026. To update your profile with these new features, follow the steps below.

Add 'Teaching Strengths'

- 1. Login to your Researcher Profile. On your homepage, select 'Edit'
- 2. On the 'Edit Profile' page, scroll down to 'Teaching Strengths'



3. Enter your identified 'Teaching Strengths' in the available rows. Select from a pre-defined list of teaching strengths that will be suggested to you as you type, or enter your own variation up to a limit of 50 characters. Select 'Save' at the bottom of the page



4. Your 'Teaching Strengths' will appear on the left-hand side of your Researcher Profile, beneath your profile photo




Add 'Availability for media comment'

- 1. Login to your Researcher Profile. On your homepage, select 'Edit'
- 2. On the 'Edit Profile' page, scroll down to 'Available for Media Comment'



3. From the drop-down menu, select 'Available for Media Comment'. Select 'Save' at the bottom of the page



4. Your Researcher Profile will be updated to include an 'Available for Media Comment' badge on your profile page (beneath your name/title, position and School/Faculty details), as well as via your icon on the Researcher Profile search directory as follows:
