


Altmetric Explorer: Search for an Author

Introduction

Altmetric Explorer has two search functions, a quick search and an advanced search. If you try the quick search and get a high number of results or are having trouble finding a particular author, using the advanced search option is recommended.


Procedure

1. To use the simple search, click your mouse in the **Quick search...** box





2. Start typing the author's name. As you type, a search results list will be generated. Click on the author's name next to **Verified authors from The University of Adelaide** to view their research outputs.




- To use the advanced search options, click on **EDIT SEARCH**.



- On the **Advanced search** screen, type the name you wish to search for into the **Verified Author** field.
- Scroll down the list of search results and click on an author's name to add it to the field.



- Add information to any other fields as required and click **RUN SEARCH**.



- Any results matching your search criteria will be displayed on the **HIGHLIGHTS** tab. To see more information about individual research outputs, click on the **RESEARCH OUTPUTS** tab.
