


# **Quick Reference Guide to Teaching Activities**

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## **Editing your Teaching Activities**

1. To add and / or edit a description of your teaching activities, firstly login to your profile.



2. Select the **Teaching** tab from the Home Page. Click the Teaching Activities Link to edit.



3. Scroll down to the **Teaching** text area. Enter a description of your Teaching Activities, or cut and paste from another source into the window (for example your CV). Click **Save** when you have completed your entry.





Note: The Cancel option will close the Edit window without saving changes.



## Adding a Formatted Table - Teaching information

- 1. It is possible to apply formatting and tables within the edit window by using HTML code. There are two example options provided.
  - a. Option 1. Course Summary Table
  - b. Option 2. Separate Course Table for Courses Taught, Courses Developed and Courses Coordinated

See below for an example of titles and tables that have been added and how they display. Individual should decide on which option suites their needs best.

**Note**: The **Cancel** option will close the Edit window without saving changes.




7. The **Teaching** area will now appear updated on your Profile Page with a Status message confirming the update.






## **Text Editor icons explained**
