# H-index and Citations

Aurora searches for citation data on publications from online sources including Scopus, Web of Science and PubMed.

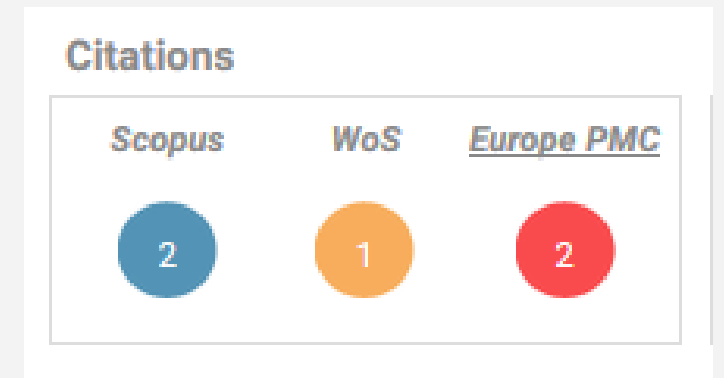
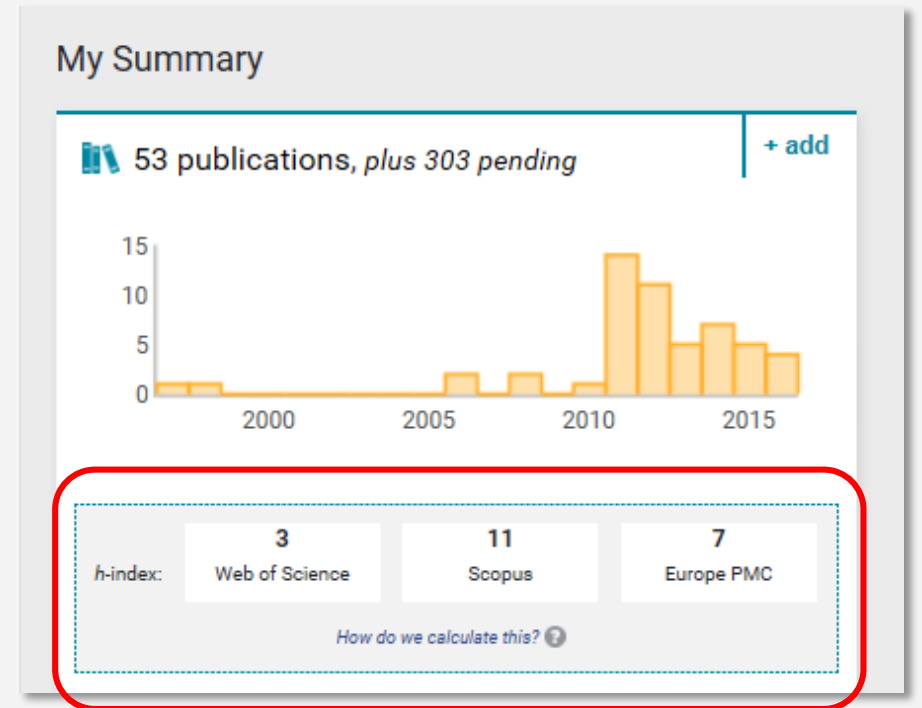
From these data your **h-index** for each of Web of Science, Scopus and European Pub Med Central is displayed in Aurora in the **h-index** panel, under **My Summary** on the **Home** page.

The number of citations per publication from these three sources is shown both on the Summary and Detailed display of publications in the Citations box.

Researchers are encouraged to ensure all their publications are captured in Aurora to ensure their citation and h-index information are accurately reflected.

Researchers may notice their h-index is slightly lower than expected. This is because some records may be missing from Aurora.
