



# Connecting to Eduroam Android

## Introduction

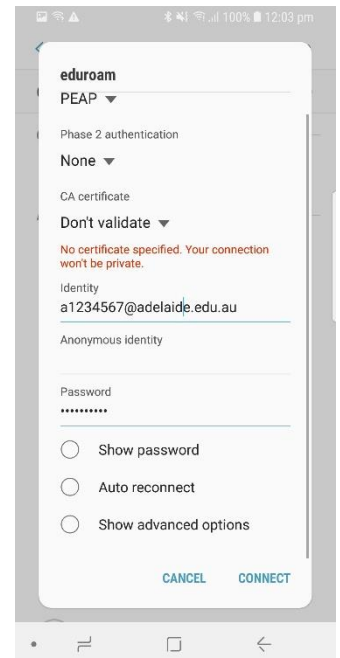
This guide will assist you in connecting to the eduroam network, which allows you to connect to over more than half of Australian universities with your UofA credentials. **It is important to note that the username for this network is slightly different than your normal UofA wireless credentials.**

*It is strongly recommended that you connect to the eduroam network while on a UofA campus before attempting the connection elsewhere.*

## Procedure

This guide was written using Samsung Galaxy devices. Due to the nature of the Android OS, these instructions may vary slightly for other branded Android devices.

1. After unlocking your phone, make sure you are on the home screen.
2. In your applications find 'Settings'.  
*Please note: 'Settings' and 'Google Settings' are different applications – in this case, we are after 'Settings'.*
3. Select Connections in the settings menu.
4. Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled (indicated by a blue switch) and tap on Wi-Fi
5. Find the 'eduroam' network
6. In the Identity box, enter your 'a' number followed by @adelaide.edu.au (eg [a1234567@adelaide.edu.au](mailto:a1234567@adelaide.edu.au))
7. Then enter in your password and click 'Connect'
8. You will see eduroam obtain an IP address, and then show as 'Connected'.
