



Connecting Wireless Android

Introduction

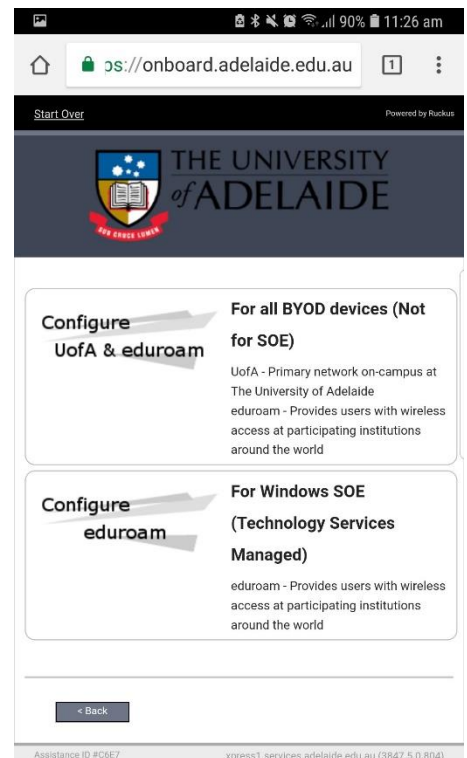
This guide will assist you in connecting your Android phone to the University Wireless.

Please note that this will automatically connect you every time you are within range, until you change your password.

Procedure

This guide was written using Samsung Galaxy device. Due to the nature of the Android OS, these instructions may vary slightly for other branded Android devices.

1. Select Wi-Fi in the settings menu.
2. Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled (indicated by a switch)
3. If you have no 3g/4g access, connect to the Uofa-help wifi network
4. In a web browser navigate to <https://onboard.adelaide.edu.au>
5. Tick the check box to agree to the Terms & Conditions and tap on 'Start'
6. Sign in with your UserID (a1234567) and password
7. Select 'Configure UofA & EduRoam'
8. Next, tap on 'Install the Network'
9. You may be prompted to install an app 'Cloudpath" allow this to install.
10. You should now see a screen confirming your connection to the UofA wifi network with the IP address.
