



# Signing into Jabber Pidgin

## Introduction

This guide will assist connecting your Jabber account to the messaging software Pidgin.  
*Please note 'Pidgin' is not provided by Cisco and therefore some features may not be available*

## Procedure

1. In Pidgin select add account.
2. For protocol select 'XMPP'
3. Set username as your first name and last name separated by a period (e.g. firstname.lastname), the domain as 'adelaide.edu.au' and then your university password.
4. Select the 'Advanced' and set Connection Security to 'Require Encryption'
5. Set the port as 5222
6. Under 'Connect Server' and 'File Transfer Proxies' enter adeunicup01.voip.net.adelaide.edu.au
7. Select the Add button
