The intimate piano and cello recital featuring the works of Bach, Beethoven, and Schumann performed by Sally McLoughlin on cello and James Huon George on piano was such a beautiful way to end 2021 at Urrbrae House. Hearing that the program offered by these talented young musicians was the culmination of Sally's Master's studies at the Elder Conservatorium made the event even more memorable for those attending.

Vale Emeritus Professor James (Jim) Quirk

It is with sadness that we have learnt of the passing on 12 February 2022 of Emeritus Professor James (Jim) Quirk, AO, BScAgr (Syd), PhD, DSc (Lond), Hon DAgrSc (Louvain), FAIAS, FRACI, FANZAAS, FTS, FAA.

Professor Quirk was Director of the Waite Agricultural Research Institute at the University of Adelaide from 1974 to 1989. A renowned soil scientist, Jim Quirk was a Reader in Soil Science at the Waite Agricultural Research Institute from 1956-1962. He then became the Foundation Professor of Soil Science and Head of the Department of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition at the University of Western Australia from 1963 to 1974.



Jim Quirk returned to the Waite Agricultural Research Institute in 1974 when he was appointed as Director, a position he held until his retirement in 1989. He was awarded the title of Emeritus Professor in 1990.

Jim Quirk helped shape soil science in Australia with a substantial number of very significant scientific papers. His expertise was recognised internationally; for example in 1975 he was a member of the United Nations two-man team which examined the effect of the Aswan Dam on soil fertility and water management in the Nile Valley. His many awards included the Prescott, AIAS, Farrer Memorial and Mueller Medals. In 1983 he was appointed an Officer of the Order of Australia for services to agriculture and agricultural research.

Adelaide Fringe events

Urrbrae House was once again the venue for Basketry SA's biennial exhibition of contemporary basketry and fibre sculptures as part of the Adelaide Fringe from 19 February to 1 March. Part proceeds from the "Made while Nobody was Looking" exhibition went to the Friends of the Waite Arboretum (FWA). Basketry SA has strong connections with the FWA and some of the basketry material used in the artworks was actually grown in the Arboretum.



The ballroom was the venue for another Fringe event, the "4 Greatest Classical B's - Bach & Beethoven & Brahms & Bartok" concert by the Adelaide Virtuosi Trio. Violinists Marta Sutora and Matej Sutora, who are part of the Trio, have been members of eminent Slovak, Czech, and Austrian orchestras with whom they have performed across the world. The third performer in the ensemble is pianist Adam Rybovic who was born in Australia, and graduated in music composition and piano from the University of Adelaide.
